Advanced Placement (AP)

- Opportunity to study a subject in greater depth while preparing students for success at post-secondary institutions
- May gain credit for university courses at the 30 level only
- Area of passion



Recommendations:

- All 4s or 80%+ in that subject to take AP with a strong interest in the subject.
- Majority 3s or 65%+ in that subject to take -1 in grade 10
- 1s/majority 2s or below 65% for -2 in ELA or SS in grade 10
- 3s/4s or above 50% for Math 15/10c or Science 10
- 1s/2s or below 50% for Math 10-3 and Science 14







Possible Sequences - Mathematics Course Sequences





Individualized Program Plan (IPP)

- Homeroom teacher is first point of contact regarding an IPP
- Most accommodations and supports are focused on student growth within the classroom
- Accommodations common at CMHS:
 - extra time on evaluations in place for ALL students
 - quiet space <u>classroom</u> is the "quiet space", especially for assessments
 - · preferential seating in the classroom based on students' needs
 - ambient noise pre-loaded MP3 players are available *not bluetooth*
 - trifold on the desk reduces visual input/distractions
 - earplugs
 - fidgets
 - speech-to-text for written assessments, completed at the CTC
 - text-to-speech students using text-to-speech have access to a laptop and headphones in the classroom during assessments




